WGA POLICIES

MEMBERSHIP

Women members with full golfing privileges, (either as Active member or Golfing Spouse/ Significant Other) are automatically enrolled as members of the WGA at MHCC. A woman member is defined as female at birth and age 18 and older.

ETIQUETTE

Knowledge of good golf manners is essential to playing the game. To enhance her pleasure in the game, and that of her fellow golfers, each player is urged to read and practice USGA Rules of Golf, Section 1, "Etiquette."

PACE OF PLAY

1. During play, it is **IMPERATIVE** that your group keeps pace with the group you're following. If for any reason there is a hole open between your group and the group ahead, the group behind yours has the right to play through. **THIS IS A COURTESY THAT SHOULD BE TREATED WITH UTMOST RESPECT.**
2. Play without delay. Always be ready to hit your ball when your turn comes. When you have the honor, be prepared to tee off promptly. After your group has holed out on the putting green, head for the next tee promptly. You can mark the scorecard there.
3. Leave golf cart between the green and the NEXT tee before you putt out, so you can move quickly from the tee.
4. **SLOW PLAY IS INEXCUSABLE.** Habitual violators will be notified by the Golf Committee.

GOLFING ATTIRE

We are permitted to wear Bermuda shorts, regulation golf shorts, culottes, skirts and slacks. No "short" shorts, halters, tank tops, or other extremes of dress. NO JEANS. This applies to members and guests.

WOMEN'S TROPHY CLUB

The Women's Trophy Club was established several years ago to enhance WGA events and to make the WGA at MHCC a strong and viable organization. Dues are invoiced annually to support the Trophy Club Fund which is used to reduce costs associated with women's golf events throughout the year. Membership includes Signature Trophy Club Bag Tag, handbook, entry fees, food and cash prizes for designated events. ***The Trophy Club is open to WGA members only.***

The annual cost for membership is \$120.

Non-Trophy Club Fees:

WGA members who opt out of joining the Trophy Club are eligible to play in designated events but will be charged an entry fee. Fee structure is as follows or as noted with each event description:

Event partially covered by Trophy Club = \$20 fee

Event entirely covered by Trophy Club = \$40 fee

RAIN DELAYS OR RAINOUTS

Do not assume because it is raining that an event is automatically cancelled! The decision to delay or cancel events due to rain will be that of the Golf Shop, the Greens keeper, and the Event Chairwoman. Please call the Golf Shop to find out if an event is officially cancelled or postponed.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In order to help the Golf Shop and the Tournament Committee better manage and control tournaments, we ask that all participants of WGA and Mixed events inform the professional staff no later than 48 hours in advance if they're unable to participate in a particular event. This allows enough time for that event to be adjusted accordingly.

HANDICAP & SCORE POSTING POLICY

HANDICAPS

Throughout the course of the season, it is imperative that all scores played by WGA Members are posted through the GHIN app. This includes all 18-hole and 9-hole scores played with **AT LEAST ONE OTHER PERSON** in the group. ANY ROUNDS PLAYED AS A SINGLE ARE NOT TO BE POSTED.

- Players are responsible for posting their own scores with the exception of WGA and Mixed events, where their score will be posted by the Pro Shop via Golf Genius. A general rule that can be followed is that if a player's score is being kept on Golf Genius, the Professional Staff will post their score. If it's not, it will be the player's responsibility.
- Please point out to your fellow players when they are not observing either the Rules of Golf or the Handicap System. We are determined to keep our games as equitable as possible and can only do so if the Rules of Golf are followed.

MAXIMUM HANDICAP

All skill levels are invited and encouraged to play in events; however, for net tournaments and Thursday Game Day events, a maximum handicap will be designated meaning the number of strokes given will be capped. Golfers with a handicap index higher than the cap will default to the maximum strokes allowed for the event. Example: If an event has a maximum handicap of 30 strokes, a player with a 42 handicap will receive 30 strokes for the event.

- **All tees for Thursday Ladies' Day Events/ Games will have a maximum of 30 strokes allotted.**
- **All tees for NON-Flighted Tournaments will have a maximum of 30 strokes allotted.**
- **Maximum Handicap for flighted events will be determined by the Pro Shop and WGA Events Committee.**

EQUITABLE STROKE CONTROL:

For handicap purposes the score returned for any hole shall be limited in accordance with the USGA "Equitable Stroke Control", which states that all players can take a NET double bogey max on any particular hole.

An example of a "net" double bogey would be:

- Player A's course handicap is 18 from the red tees.
- Player A will receive 18 strokes, 1 per hole, for that day's event
- If Player A makes a 9 on a par 4, the maximum score they could post for that hole would be a 7.
Calculation: (4 (par) + 2 (double bogey) + 1 (handicap for the hole) = 7

ALL SCORES, HOME OR AWAY, MUST BE POSTED, NO EXCEPTIONS!

You are reminded to please inform the Pro Shop when you have that fantastic round and break 70, 80, 90 or 100 for the first time!! Also, note personal bests in the Ringer/ Birdie Binder located in the ladies' lounge.

EVENTS & TOURNAMENTS

*(TC) denotes event partially or entirely paid for by Trophy Club

SEASON LONG EVENTS:

SEASON LONG RINGER TOURNAMENT (TC)

A Ringer is a score on an individual hole that betters any previous score on that hole. During the period from Opening Day (April 24th) to Closing Day (September 25th), a player builds an **18-hole** score using the lowest **GROSS** score she makes on each hole during the season from either the RED or GREEN tees **(MAKE SURE TO WRITE YOUR SCORES IN THE RINGER BINDER, LOCATED IN THE LADIES LOUNGE, HYBRID PLAYERS SHOULD USE THE RED RINGER SHEET!)**. You can get a ringer on a hole during any **18-hole** round of golf but you must PUTT out the hole. Simply change the score on the Ringer Binder located in the Ladies' Locker Room Lounge. Cash Prizes from the Trophy Fund will be awarded on Ladies' Closing Day Dinner. Last day to post scores for Ringers is *Thursday September 25th, 2025*

Only Trophy Club members are eligible for prizes!!

BIRDIES (TC)

A player who scores a natural birdie on a hole(s) during an **18-hole round** should record the birdie(s) in the Ringer Binder located in Ladies' Locker Room Lounge. This must be a natural gross birdie. **Mulligans may not be used.** Cash prize from the Trophy Fund will be awarded for the greatest number of birdies *from April 1st through Thursday, September 25th.*

Only Trophy Club members are eligible for prizes!!

MOST IMPROVED GOLFER (TC)

A cash prize from the Trophy Fund will be awarded for the most improved golfer. The Golf Shop will reference the GHIN Most Improved Player report to award this at Ladies' Closing Day Dinner.

Only Trophy Club members are eligible for prize!!

SEASON LONG ONE-WOMAN 9 AND 18 HOLE TOURNAMENTS (TC)

All WGA Members with an established handicap are eligible for the tournament. Participants will be seeded in brackets based upon their handicap index on May 25th. New for this year, both a 9-hole and 18-hole tournament are planned. Also, new this year, two separate flights may be created based on the number of participants. Flights for this event based on the Median Average of Handicap Indexes. Players with handicap indexes below the median average will enter one match play bracket, while players with a higher index than the median will enter a separate match play bracket. The event is a match play, single elimination event, using full handicap. Your current handicap will be used for tournament play. Check the Pro Shop the day you play for your handicap. Any interested golfers **MUST** sign up by *May 24th*. Ties will be decided by a sudden death playoff beginning on hole #1. Each match **MUST** be played on or by the designated deadline listed below. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Round 1 matches can begin play on Wednesday, May 28th, 2025. Prize awards are determined by the number of participants. **Non-Trophy Club members will be charged \$30 fee.**

- * Round 1 Deadline: Wednesday, July 2nd
- * Round 2 Deadline: Sunday, August 3rd
- * Round 3 Deadline: Thursday, September 11th
- * Round 4 Deadline (If needed) Sunday, October 5th

All matches must be played prior to the Round Deadlines. If an outcome cannot be agreed upon then match will be decided by a coin toss.

SEASON LONG TWO WOMEN 9 AND 18 HOLE TOURNAMENTS (TC)

All WGA Members with an established handicap are eligible for the tournament. Team handicaps are determined by combining the handicap indexes of both team members. New for this year, both a 9-hole and 18-hole tournament are planned. Also, new this year, two separate flights may be created based on the number of participants. The flights will be determined using the median combined handicap indexes of each team based upon their handicap index on May 25th. The lower index teams will enter one match play bracket, and the higher handicap index teams will enter a separate match play bracket. The event is a better ball, match play, single elimination event. Teams current handicap will be used for tournament play. Check the Pro Shop the day you play for your handicap. Any interested golfers ***MUST*** sign up by ***May 22th, and after that date, teams will be FINAL. Substitutions will not be permitted at any time following the 5/22 sign-up deadline.*** Matches ending in ties will be decided by a sudden death playoff beginning on hole #1. Each match ***MUST*** be played on or by the designated deadline listed below. NO EXCEPTIONS! Round 1 matches can begin play on Sunday May 25th, 2025. Prize awards are determined by the number of participants. **Non-Trophy Club members will be charged \$30 fee.**

- * Round 1 Deadline: Wednesday July 2nd
- * Round 2 Deadline: Sunday, August 3rd
- * Round 3 Deadline: Thursday, September 11th
- * Round 4 Deadline: (if needed) Sunday, October 5th

All matches must be played prior to the Round Deadlines. If a member of the team cannot play on an agreed upon match day they may reschedule if it's prior to the deadline or may play as a single to complete the match. If an outcome cannot be agreed upon then the match will be decided by a coin toss.
